



Position Title: Women's Reserves Team Coach – Hockey Geelong Sharks

Reports to: Head Coach and HG Sharks Committee

Position Overview: The Reserves Team Coach is responsible for supporting the Head Coach in providing leadership for the Reserves hockey team. This includes assisting in the development and implementation of team and player development strategies, ensuring alignment with the HG Sharks' values and Code of Conduct. Responsibilities include coaching the Reserves team on match days, overseeing training programs, and collaborating closely with the Head Coach, Team Manager, and the HG Sharks Committee. This position is offered as a one-year contract.

Key Responsibilities:

Leadership and Strategy:

- **Program Support:** Provide direction and leadership for the Reserves hockey team.
- **Strategy Development:** Support the development and implementation of hockey strategies, including training programs and game plans.
- **Coaching Support:** Overseeing coaching aspects, including player development and match play strategies.
- **Team Selection:** Collaborate with the captain and vice-captain in the team selection process.

- **Player Feedback:** Provide constructive feedback to players regarding their development, progress, and performance.
- **Player Surveys:** Assist in conducting mid-season and end-of-season player surveys to gather insights and improve team dynamics.

- **Talent Acquisition:** Assist in identifying and recruiting new players to enhance the Club's roster.
- **Player Development:** Support the retention, recruitment, and development of players for the Reserves program.
