2018 PRE-NOMINATION INFORMATION

Nominating for the 2018 Hockey Geelong's Junior Sharks Representative Teams involves 2 Selection Trials.

Players can only nominate for their nominal age and gender - e.g. girls will play in Girls' teams; U14 players will play in U14 teams.

If a nominating player cannot attend a Selection Trial, they must fill in a Exemption Form. Contact the Junior Representative Co-ordinator before the Trials and return the form before the first trial.

Previous team/squad selection does not guarantee future selection in subsequent teams/squads.

Players must bring **BOTH** WHITE and BLACK SHIRTS to Selection Trials.

Please note: No Hockey Geelong Rep, JSC, Zone or any State clothing (incl. socks) to be worn at Selection Trials; players will be asked to change their clothing if this is breached – no exceptions.

Please leave all Zone or State hoodies, trackpants, hockey bags, drink bottles, or other such equipment at home as well.

It is envisaged teams will compose a maximum of 16 players (1 x GK and up to 15 field players). If the Coaches/Junior Rep Sub-committee consider it to be in the squad's best interests, it may - in addition to the named team – have Train-ons and/or Rotational Train-ons.

Written Feedback will be given to non-selected players who attend Selection Trials. Players may be cut after the 1st Selection Trial.

In the event the JRS can name a Team/Squad after the 1st Selection Trial, the JRS can decide not to hold a 2nd Selection Trial for that team; the coach of that team/squad may electing to start training instead.

The JRS may select a squad that will train for up to 3 weeks before announcing the actual team.

Weekly training attendance is compulsory.

Season Fees: approx \$260.00 (GST inclusive) – to be confirmed.

Nominations close Friday, February 1, 2018.

2018 TEAM SELECTION AND ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

To be read in conjunction with the Pre-nomination Information and HG Sharks Junior Representative Policy

- Players are eligible to trial for selection in a Hockey Geelong Sharks Junior Representative Team/Squad if they are a registered member of an affiliated club/school, and playing or supporting local Geelong Association hockey on a regular basis.
 - **Please note:** Player selection from sources outside Geelong Hockey Association will be considered by the Junior Representative Sub-Committee (JRS) on an individual basis. Please contact the Hockey Geelong Junior Rep Co-ordinator (JRC) for more information.
- Only players who attend Selection Trials shall be eligible for selection, unless there are
 exceptional circumstances that prevent a player from attending. Non-attending players
 must fill in the Exemption Form prior to the trials. Please contact the JRC for more
 information.
- Selection in a team/squad will be based on gender and/or age where sufficient numbers permit. Teams entered into the various competitions will be determined by available nominated players for that age group. See *Hockey Geelong Sharks Junior Representative Policy* document on Hockey Geelong website for more clarification.

For the 2018 season, players may only nominate to trial for selection in teams of their nominal age and gender – i.e. Girls will play in girls' teams; U14 players will play in U14 teams.

- The JRS may refuse, approve or impose conditions upon the selection of any players.
- Any player vacancy which occurs in a selected team/squad during the season due to illness, injury etc., may be filled by the JRS, in consultation with the Head Coach and/or Team Coaches.
- The JRS may invite players individually to the Selection Trials. This will not exclude any eligible player from nominating to trial. If a player has been invited by the JRS to the Selection Trials, this in no way guarantees that player a spot in a team/squad.
- Consideration should be given to the needs of junior members and their commitment to study should they be selected in a Junior Representative team/squad.
- Players nominating for selection must be prepared to attend all training sessions after selection in a team/squad.
- Fees must be paid by the due date (Round 4 of competition) unless otherwise agreed prior to that date. All uniform fees must be paid prior to collecting uniforms.
- All players must agree to abide by the Codes of Behaviour as set out by Hockey Geelong and Hockey Victoria whilst representing Hockey Geelong.

- Be prepared to play the position your team needs you to play this may not always be where you prefer to play
- Don't drop your head if you make a mistake
- Do not argue with umpires
