2019 SHARKS JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE COACH POSITION DESCRIPTION

POSITION TITLE: HOCKEY GEELONG SHARKS REPRESENTATIVE JUNIOR TEAM COACH - 2019

HG Sharks Junior teams compete in the Hockey Victoria Junior Competition on Friday nights starting Friday, April 26, 2019. Games are held at Stead Park, Geelong and various Melbourne venues; may also include Ballarat and/or Bendigo. The season is 14 weeks (+ 2-week finals series for top 4).

Position Objectives:

To provide coaching and training services for Hockey Geelong Sharks's Junior Representative squad members in the 2019 Hockey Victoria Junior winter competition.

Key Responsibilities:

- Help facilitate, under the direction of the Hockey Geelong Junior Rep Co-ordinator or nominated person, the 2 x Selection Trials Sunday February 17 and Sunday February 24 (8.30am-10.30am), or as directed.
- Attendance at all matches scheduled for Friday nights at times and venues advised in fixture provided by Hockey Victoria.
- Facilitate skills training and fitness sessions during the course of the season for a minimum of 1 hr per week on a weeknight as advised by Hockey Geelong (currently Tuesday TBC).
- Represent Hockey Geelong in a professional manner at all times through leadership and by example.
- On match day, wear "Hockey Geelong" branded clothing.
- Work with and support all team members in developing their hockey skills, as well as their commitment to and enjoyment of the sport.
- Work as a team member of the Hockey Geelong Junior Sharks Representative team.
- Demonstrate by example upholding the Hockey Geelong Mission Statement and Code of Conduct.
- Gain a current Working With Children Check card before the start of the season.
- Hold, or demonstrate a commitment towards gaining, at least Level 1 Coach Accreditation (HA Hockey Ed Program). NB: Shield team coaches must be minimum Level 1.
- Abide by and enforce the policies in the 2019 Hockey Geelong Sharks Junior Representative Policy document. This document is available on the Hockey Geelong website or by contacting the Assn Secretary or Junior Representative Co-ordinator.

Organisational Relationships:

- Responsible for: Coaching, training and conduct of junior squad members.
- Liaises directly with: Hockey Geelong Junior Head Coach (if appointed); Team Head Coach, Team Assistant Coach, Team Co-Coach, or coaching assistant, where applicable; Team Manager.
- Reports to: Hockey Geelong Sharks Junior Representative Co-ordinator.
- During the season, and at the end of the season, there may be reviews conducted between yourself and a Hockey Geelong Junior Representative Sub-committee representative.

Remuneration:

Hockey Geelong is a not-for-profit sporting organisation, which relies heavily on volunteer input. The association acknowledges and appreciates the many hours of voluntary coaching during the season. The following entitlements are a reimbursement of expenses incurred in the course of that coaching.

- A total allocation of \$500.00 is made available for the position of Team Head Coach, and \$300.00 for Team Assistant Coach. Team Co-coaches are entitled to \$400.00 each.
- Payable at the end of the 2019 winter season. Upon request, half the appointed payment may be made mid-season, or earlier if payment is being put towards coach's or family member's Shark Rep player fees for that season.
- All coaches are to fill in and return an ATO "Statement by a Supplier" aka Hobby form (attached) to ensure HG is tax compliant.
