Dear Geelong Hockey Club

Re: Confirmation of COVID Safe Arrangements

You will appreciate that both Geelong Hockey Club and the City have a duty of care as occupiers and must take all reasonable care to avoid a foreseeable risk of harm by those that use the Stead Park.

As you may be aware, the Victorian Government has moved regional Victoria into the 'Third Step' of its roadmap to reopening, effective from 17 September 2020.

This provides an easing of restrictions for a range of social, sport, recreation and community activities.

The City confirms that Geelong Hockey Club can use Stead Park under the following conditions, subject to the use being allowed by the current Directions issued by Victoria's Chief Health Officer.

Geelong Hockey Club must:

- Agree to comply with the measures outlined in their previously approved COVID Safe Work Plan Questionnaire.
- Comply with the recommendations issued by the relevant state or national body, as well as the Directions of the Victorian Chief Health Officer (view them at www.dhhs.vic.gov.au/victorias-restriction-levels-covid-19).
- Immediately cease any activity at the direction of the City. This direction would be issued if the City believes continuing the activity poses a significant risk of infection or at the direction of the Victorian Chief Health Officer.
- Ensure your public liability policy is in place and can be produced upon request by the City.

We value Geelong Hockey Club's continued efforts to keep the community safe during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and we are on hand to provide support, guidance and advice where required.

The City may, on occasion, request an updated COVID Safe Work Plan. The City may also conduct onsite inspections to ensure that the stated requirements in Geelong Hockey Club's plan are in place and effectively control the risk of COVID-19 transmission.
